# **GIFF : 30** years of Beyond Cinema

# The Geneva International Film Festival (GIFF, November 1–10) presents the programming of an inspiring 30th edition.

In tune with its DNA, the Festival will offer an unprecedented panorama of contemporary audiovisual productions, including top-tier films, series, and immersive experiences. The series program stands out this year with the exclusive presentation of highly anticipated titles such as *Whiskey on the Rocks* from the team behind *The Bridge* (2011), or *Families Like Ours* by the brilliant Danish director Thomas Vinterberg, *The Confidante (Une amie dévouée)*, a series about the Bataclan mythomaniac starring the majestic Laure Calamy, *Generation Z*, Ben Wheatley's series that will set England on fire at Halloween, *L'Arte della Gioia*, a fiery literary adaptation supervised by Valeria Golino, as well as Swiss series *Winter Palace, On the High Seas*, and *Those Who Blush* which will complement this prestigious program.

In parallel, films pushing the limits of the cinematic experience will also be featured, including *The Brutalist* (Brady Corbet | 2024 | US), *Diva Futura* (Giulia Louise Steigerwalt | 2024 | IT), *Kneecap* (Rich Peppiatt | 2024 | IE, GB), *Rumours* (Evan Johnson, Galen Johnson, Guy Maddin | 2024 | CA, DE), and *Spermageddon* (Rasmus Andre Sivertsen, Tommy Wirkola | 2024 | NO). Lastly, the Festival will offer striking immersive experiences such as the Taiwanese performance *Free Ur Head*, the collaborative experience by Joséphine Dérobe *bear my soul* (*moi fauve*), the monumental digital restoration of the *Panorama of the Battle of Murten*, and the cutting-edge AI-generated video art installation *The Golden Key*.

In total, nearly **93 works** (44 films, 26 series, 23 immersive experiences), including 11 world premieres, 3 international premieres, 1 European premiere, and 54 Swiss premieres, will enliven Geneva during ten days, paying tribute to the creative vitality of today's and tomorrow's audiovisual industry.

While **Ava DuVernay** will be awarded the Film & Beyond prize, Professor **Sarah Kenderdine** will share her artistic and cultural vision in the section Tales of Swiss Innovation and Leos Carax will return to his unique and fascinating universe during a moderated conference. Guests will also include Aude Léa Rapin and Souheila Yacoub (*Planète B*), Kirill Serebrennikov (*Limonov: The Ballad of Eddie*), Louis Garrel (*Saint-Ex*), Pierre Monnard, Lindsay Shapero (*Winter Palace*), and Niels Schneider (*The World Doesn't Exist*) alongside Benjamin Voisin, Stefan Crepon (*The Quiet Son*), and Patrick Muroni (*Rave*). The numerous talented personalities expected in Geneva will meet with the audience to exchange ideas on artistic content and discuss ways to break down audiovisual boundaries, creating a direct and enriching dialogue between creators and spectators.

## INTERNATIONAL FEATURE FILM COMPETITION

Ten feature films that push stylistic boundaries and pave the way for the cinema of tomorrow will be screened as Swiss premieres. These films are competing for a Reflet d'Or worth CHF 10,000, offered by the City and Canton of Geneva, awarded by a jury chaired by Swiss filmmaker Carmen Jaquier and composed of film students.

## INTERNATIONAL SERIES COMPETITION

A key format in the audiovisual industry, the series competition explores the innovative potential of the most dynamic and influential format in contemporary audiovisual media. Ten series are on the program (two international premieres and eight Swiss premieres). They will be made accessible in their entirety thanks to an innovative format: the first episodes will be shown in theaters, while the rest of the series will be available through personalized viewing links. A jury composed of three festivalgoers will award the best series with the Reflet d'Or (CHF 10,000), offered by the City and Canton of Geneva.

A Reflet d'Or (CHF 10,000), offered by the City and Canton of Geneva and awarded by an international jury, will honor the most impactful artistic proposal.

## SWISS SERIES STORYTELLING AWARD

GIFF enters its third decade with the launch of a key project: the Swiss Series Storytelling Award, further establishing the Festival as a hub for innovation in audiovisual fiction. This prize—the first of its kind in Switzerland—aims to reward the most creative narrative universe in terms of screenplay. The winners will be announced on November 8 during a special evening, and they will receive a CHF 20,000 reward, offered by SSA and Suissimage cultural funds.

#### **GENEVA DIGITAL MARKET**

A unique event for audiovisual innovation in Switzerland, the Geneva Digital Market (GDM) returns from November 4–7. A platform for broadcasting and co-producing creative industries, its role is to bring together professionals to discuss the contemporary challenges of audiovisual creation during the *Talks* and participate in the *Market*—a European-scale market for digital works. The GDM will take place this year at Théâtre Pitoëff, Maison Communale de Plainpalais, at the heart of the Geneva International Film Festival.

Among the participants at the festival will be Elisha Karmitz (CEO, Mk2, FR), Babette Wijntjes (Founder, Cassette, Nu:Reality, NL), Marc Da Costa (Artist, US), Matthew Niederhauser (Artist, US), Annabelle Penloup (Vice President of Business Development, Technicolor Group, FR), Camille Duvelleroy (Screenwriter and Director, FR), Anaïs Garestier a.k.a Modiie (Videographer and Streamer, FR), and Marianne Levy-Leblond (Director of Digital Creations Unit, ARTE, FR).
